

- Led Covid-19 crisis management at NSCI residential rooms in 2020, providing essential services for healthcare workers residing in those rooms, earning special recognition from the Maharashtra Government.

- Organized the annual Birth Centenary celebrations of Sir Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel at NSCI for the past 20 years.





7. The Trust intends to take up more projects in the field of social responsibility and well-being and helping people uplift themselves from all walks of life.





PROJECT REPORT – MEGA DISCOUNTED HEALTH CHECK-UP FOLLOWED BY FREE DOCTOR CONSULTATION

After certainty of faith, nothing better is given to man than good health.” In alignment with this profound Hadith, and in accordance with the continued guidance of our beloved Aqa Moula Aali Qadr Syedna Muffadal Saifuddin (TUS), who consistently emphasizes the importance of physical and spiritual well-being within our Dawoodi Bohra community, a health initiative was undertaken with great purpose and devotion.

On the auspicious occasion of **Urs Mubarak of Kaka Akela Saheb and Kaki Akela Saheb (Khambhat)**, and under the valuable guidance of **Amil Saab of Zaini Masjid**, the **Anjuman-E-Abdullah Khambhat Trust**, in collaboration with **PharmEasy Labs**, successfully conducted a **Mega Discounted Health Check-Up Program**, followed by **Free Doctor Consultation**.

The Trust partnered with **NABL-accredited PharmEasy Labs** to offer a comprehensive health check-up package at a highly subsidized rate. The package covered **90 diagnostic tests** via blood and urine samples. To ensure accessibility and convenience, sample collection was offered at participants' homes. Additionally, a walk-in collection point was set up at **Zaini Masjid** for those who preferred to visit in person, with further discounts provided.

The initiative witnessed an encouraging response with **close to 100 registrations**. Of these, over **60% opted for home collection**, while the rest visited Zaini Masjid, many accompanied by their families, reflecting community spirit and health awareness.

During the program, our **Special Invitees and Guest of Honour** commended the Trust's thoughtful approach of conducting diagnostic tests before doctor consultations. This ensured that doctors had access to detailed reports, enabling **meaningful, personalized medical advice** for each participant.

PROJECT – CARDIOPULMONARY RESUSCITATION (CPR) TALK ON URS FUNCTION AT ZAINEE HALL. DATE – 18TH AUG 24, 13TH SAFAR 1446H

In today's fast paced world, where people are under stress for small things which can lead to dire health issues, taking care and being aware of emergency care is important. With that in mind, we organised a talk on Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), a lifesaving technique that's useful in Cardiac arrest, in which one's breathing or heartbeat has stopped.

The talk with audiovisual was delivered by Dr.Tasneem Dhansura, Head of Anaesthesia Dept, Saifee Hospital. It was very interesting and captivating. Our Chief Guest Mehlam BhaiSaheb Burhani and special invitees Shk.Huzaifabhai Shehabi and Shk.Hussainbhai Nalwala interacted with the speaker. She along with her team demonstrated how to do CPR and called upon the participants to volunteer and try the technique on a dummy model.

Mehlum BS also volunteered and learnt how to give proper CPR. It was a good and recap session for everyone that gave insight on the Do's and Don'ts of a cardiac emergency.

Some of the talk highlights - Cardiac arrest is a sudden and unexpected loss of heart function. During cardiac arrest, the heart stops pumping blood to the body and brain, leading to rapid loss of consciousness and breathing.

Symptoms of cardiac arrest:

- Sudden collapse,
- No pulse, No breathing.
- Loss of consciousness.
- Sometimes other symptoms may occur before sudden cardiac arrest, such as chest discomfort, shortness of breath, weakness, or palpitations.
- However, sudden cardiac arrest occurs with no warning.

Once the symptoms are observed, an immediate intervention, Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) can be used to revive the patient until medical help is reached.







Had an insightful and educative experience on attending lecture of Dr. Saifuddin Kapasi.

Key points, rather "mantras" learned were

- 1) Muda (waste)
- 2) Mura (unevenness)
- 3) Muri (overburden)

with excellent examples to enable us to use not just in our business but also in various aspects of our lives.

He commenced with a story about a house on 5th floor on fire and people watching from below, shouting, waiting for something to happen or the fire brigade to arrive. A child is trapped and the mother calls for help. A person takes initiative to help. He is a goalkeeper and installs in mother confidence to throw down the child. Person catches the child BUT he kicks it as a ball!!

In this example he tried to make us understand that everyone of us has some ability to react and do something useful. However, the specialized training, he did not adopt to change as he kicked the child like a ball which as a goalkeeper he was trained to do.

He shared an example of Muda by Mr. Masai Imai from Japan who was invited by Taj Hotel to hold a workshop for its staff in the conference room. The staff were very sceptical - the hotel is doing excellent business, this person from Japan has no exposure to the hotel industry - what exactly is he going to teach?

Mr. Masai started with, "Good morning! Let's start work. I am told this is a workshop, but I see neither work nor shop. So, let's proceed where work is happening. Let's start with the first room on the first floor, which happened to be the laundry room. "A room with such a beautiful view is being wasted as a laundry room. Shift the laundry to the basement and convert this into a guest room." he said and the rest was history.

Dr Kapasi shared another story about Muda, Mura & Muri about empowering any worker to take action to shut down an entire factory (Toyota automobile) if he even sees a drop of oil on the shop floor (not major problem like fire or machine failure).

To be able identify and avoid any "waste: is "Muda" & to have "relevance where one can identify whether any "value" is added to any business activity is "Mura".

He shared another story about "observation" by showing a picture about a cart with square wheels but loaded with round wheels and a person pushing / pulling the cart.

He said that in any business decisions one needs to first "observe" and then decide on a course of action.

He continued by giving an example of 2 experienced hunters who had packed up and on returning, coming across a ferocious lion. They run carrying whatever is possible, bare footed. However, one person stops n sits down other thinks he is a fool to stop. That person spent some time to wear shoes. Eventually he was able to outrun the 1st person because he spent some to "observe" the situation and take appropriate action.

He explained that for the final journey of life in business or any other situation, one needs to observe, take stock of the issue, take corrective action and then decide on a proper response.

He also shared an example of a loaded cart and whether it is easier to pull it or push it. By using an analogy of a cart puller, he explained that even though pushing is easier but pulling consumes overall less energy and also gives control to the person.

So overall, his explanations and analogy to real life situations, his lecture was indeed educational and appropriate to use in business and other life situations to ensure that waste is minimized and using power of observation to iron out unevenness and overburdening of any resources in our business.

KHAMBHAT : A JOURNEY THROUGH TIME

BY TASNEEM ABBAS KHAMBATY

Khambhat (formerly Cambay) boasts a rich heritage that stretches back thousands of years. It was a prominent hub of trade and culture, dating back to the Harappan Civilization. The city's strategic location on the western coast of India made it an ideal maritime port, attracting traders, explorers, and empires across centuries.

Archaeologist Cat Jarman discovered that **agate and carnelian beads**, linked to Harappan craftsmanship, were being manufactured in Khambhat **as early as 5000 years ago**, and exported globally via the Gulf of Khambhat. These artifacts are among the oldest proofs of India's early engagement in international trade.



Golden Age of Trade (10th – 16th Century)

From the **10th to the 16th century**, Khambhat flourished as one of India's premier port cities. Its exports included silk, chintz, gold-threaded textiles, buckram, cotton, and leather. The port connected India with **the Arabian Peninsula, East Africa, and Southeast Asia**, playing a crucial role in the **Maritime Silk Route**.

Notable visitors and records:

- **915 AD:** Arab historian **Al-Masudi** described Khambhat as a **thriving cosmopolitan port** with impressive architecture and a bustling international community.
- **1293:** Venetian explorer **Marco Polo** noted Khambhat as **one of the richest towns in India**, a major stop for merchants on their maritime routes.
- **1342:** Moroccan traveler **Ibn Battuta** praised the city's artistic beauty, remarking on the **wealthy foreign merchants** who built grand homes and mosques to showcase their affluence.

MUGHAL ERA (16TH – 18TH CENTURY)

Khambhat became part of the Mughal Empire when Emperor Akbar captured Gujarat in 1573. Though silting of the gulf began reducing its prominence as a port, it remained a major commercial centre, especially for textile production.

- The city specialized in silks, cotton, chintz, broadcloth, indigo, and embroidered fabrics, all closely monitored to sustain imperial revenue.
- Islamic architectural influence grew significantly, with the construction of the Jami Mosque in 1325, a masterpiece by architect Umar bin Ahmad al-Kazaruni during the reign of Sultan Alauddin Khilji. It is one of the oldest mosques in Gujarat.


Colonial Influence & Decline

Khambhat's fortunes began to wane with increased silting, shifts in trade routes, and colonial reorganization. Yet its cultural and historical significance endured.

- Nawab Mirza Zafar Mumin Khan I, the last Mughal collector, established the Khambhat province in 1730, marking the end of an era.
- British colonial interest remained, with James Forbes, an East India Company writer and artist, sketching Khambhat's Dil Khush Garden and the south end of the port in the late 1700s.
- The earliest recorded cricket match in India took place here in 1721, played by British sailors under Lt. Clement Downing, who documented it in his 1737 memoir.

The Mecca Gate in Khambhat, also known as Meccai Gate or Bāb Makkah, is a historically and culturally significant landmark located near the seafront. This gate served as the main departure point for Hajj pilgrims from the region, who would begin their sacred journey to Makkah (Saudi Arabia) by sea. For generations, this gateway symbolized a spiritual passage and held deep emotional resonance for the community — a place where families would bid farewell to loved ones embarking on the pilgrimage. Today, Mecca Gate stands as a heritage symbol, reflecting Khambhat's long-standing religious, maritime, and cultural legacy.

A Timeless City

Khambhat—once an ancient trade port, later a vibrant Mughal commercial hub, and eventually a colonial landmark—tells a compelling story of adaptation, resilience, and global connection. Through centuries of shifting tides, it has remained a beacon of cultural richness and enterprise. Its layered heritage—reflected in its architecture, literature, trade, and traditions—transforms Khambhat from a mere city into a living museum of India's maritime and cultural legacy.

MOULAI ABDULLAH SAHEB




The Kubbah and Zarih Mubarak of Moulai Abdulla Saheb, who is revered for bringing light of Imaan from Yemen to India



The plaques within the sanctified Kubbah Mubarakah of Moulai Abdulla Saheb record that this blessed structure—reflecting the beauty and sanctity of Jannat al-Firdaus—was constructed during the illustrious era of Syedna Taher Saifuddin RA, and was dedicated as waqf on 2nd July, 1923 (1341H). They also chronicle the noble life and miracles of Moulai Abdulla Saheb, who, under the guidance of the Fatemi Duat, journeyed from Yemen and laid the foundational roots of Dawat in the Indian subcontinent. His mission brought the light of Imaan to these lands, and his legacy continues to inspire generations of Mumineen.

MOULAI AHMED SAHEB

 Moulai Ahmed Saheb, alongside Moulai Abdulla Saheb, played a pivotal role in bringing and spreading the light of **Imaan** in the Indian subcontinent as early as **460 Hijri (12th Century AD)**. His arrival marked a foundational moment in the history of **Dawat**, and his enduring legacy continues to illuminate the hearts of Mumineen. This **Kubbah Mubarakah** stands as a tribute to his unwavering devotion and sacred mission.

KAKA AKELA AND KHAKI AKELA SAHEB



The Zarih Mubarak of Kaka Akela and Kaki Akela Saheba stands as a revered symbol of piety and remembrance, honoring their noble legacy with grace and sanctity



During the era of Imam Mustansir (A.S.) [427–467 H.], the proclamation of Dawat in Hindustan began with his blessed *raza*. He sent Maulai Abdulla (R.A.), Maulai Ahmedshah (R.A.), and Maulai Nooruddin (R.A.) to Khambhat. Near the village of Kavadra, in Sakarpur, they arrived at the farm of Kaka Akela, a member of the Kunbi community.

Though the land and well were barren, their presence brought barakat—the fields became fertile, and sweet water miraculously flowed from the dry well after Maulai Abdulla (R.A.) struck it with his staff. Kaka Akela and Kaki Akela were the first to embrace Imaan, leading many others to do the same.




Today, a Qubba stands over their graves, surrounded by a newly built courtyard and garden. The well still flows and is believed to hold healing properties, benefiting the many zaereen who visit.






Khambhat holds the rare and distinguished honour of having been graced, on multiple occasions, by the presence of all three Dai's who have led the Dawat over the past 100 years. This remarkable legacy reflects the town's spiritual importance and its strong, lasting bond with the respected leaders of the Dawat over the centuries.

SAIFEE MASJID, KHAMBHAT

Syedna Taher Saifuddin (R.A.) visited **Khambhat** on numerous occasions. He graciously gave **irshād** for the **construction of the Qubba Mubāraka of Maulaya Abdullah (R.A.)**.

Syedna Taher Saifuddin (R.A.) delivered the **Ashara Mubāraka** wa'az in Khambhat in the year 1359 Hijri (1940 CE) — the only time Ashara Mubāraka has been held in Khambhat.

Syedna Mohammed Burhanuddin (R.A.) visited **Khambhat** in 1391 Hijri, where he delivered a **wa'az on the 27th of Rajab**, commemorating the day of **Mabas** (the declaration of Prophethood). On **1st Shabaan**, he also presided over the **urs majlis of Syedna Hebatullah (R.A.)**. Later, in **1407 Hijri**, Syedna Mohammed Burhanuddin (R.A.) once again graced Khambhat with his presence and conducted the **urs majlis of Syedna Noor Mohammed Nuruddin (R.A.)**.

Syedna Aaliqadr Mufaddal Saifuddin TUS ye Khambhat ni Saifee Masjid ni tareef ma em farmayu ke aa masjid purani che, pan ghani khubi daar che, tame yaha na logo bhi khubi daar cho. The plaque at Saifee Masjid, Khambhat, records that the Masjid was built during the era of Syedna Taher Saifuddin RA by Abedin Kamruddin, who funded its construction from his personal wealth. The Masjid was dedicated as waqf to Syedna Taher Saifuddin RA on 5th Jamadil Aakhar 1344H (20th December, 1925)



JAMAAT KHANA, KHAMBHAT





On the blessed occasion of the visit of Huzur-e-Aali Syedna Taher Saifuddin RA to Khambhat, and in celebration of this joyful moment, the Dawoodi Kasruz Ziyafat Alviya Ahmad Jamaat Khana was constructed. It was built on originally waqf (endowed) land by Raees Shk. Ahmad Shk. Dawood, along with his son Abdul Ali and daughter Khadija Bai, for the sawaab (spiritual reward) of their family.

Laalbu binte Rehmat Ali Parekh and her son Tayyab Ali Abdul Ali, seeking only the pleasure of Allah Ta'ala, spent Rs. 62,000 to construct this beautiful structure. It was built under the supervision of Qurban Hussain Rehmat Ali Parekh and Hatim Bhai Rehmat Ali Parekh and was then dedicated as waqf (Ihvaajillah) for sacred purposes.

To bring joy, we introduced them to Dadu, a traditional game, which brought laughter and smiles all around. We gifted them the game so they could continue enjoying it.

Lunch was wholesome—gravy, vegetables, fruits, and salad—highlighting the home's focus on health. A nurse is available, and a dialysis center is onsite, with hospital visits arranged if needed. The home currently shelters 18 residents, each with a touching life story. They are cared for with love, and not charged a single rupee—everything is run on donations. As a gesture of support, we donated ₹53,000 and brought fruits for the residents.

This visit left us deeply moved. It was not just about giving, but connecting, learning, and appreciating the dignity and warmth the elderly receive thanks to Shk. Hussain Bhai Nalwala's selfless efforts. A day that will stay with us forever.


The sessions are planned at regular cadence, around preventive healthcare, self and professional development and environmental conservation.



I am Yahya Miyajiwala, born in the historic town of Khambhat and residing in Bombay for the past 75 years. It fills my heart with immense pride and joy to witness Anjuman-e-Abdullah complete 100 glorious years of service and dedication.

I feel honoured to have been associated with this noble trust in its formative years. I still fondly remember my late father, Mulla Moiz Bhai Miyajiwala, who would often speak to me about the inception of the trust. In those days, it was common for Mumineen in Bombay to organize their Gaam no Urs Jaman independently. Inspired by this, my father and a few close friends initiated the Urs of Kaka Akela and Kaki Akela in Mumbai.

This gathering brought together Khambhatis from all parts of the city. Each person contributed what they could, and together we arranged a Jaman that wasn't just about food—it became a reunion of hearts. It was a time for our people to connect, share memories, and strengthen bonds.

KHAMBHAT – NURTURING HEALTH AND HEALING FOR CENTURIES BY DR.SHK.SHABBIR ADENWALA

Khambhat, historically known as Cambay, had a rich history as a significant trading port and capital of the princely state of Cambay. Apart from that, Khambhat was also pioneer in the field of medicine. This attracted patients from far and near regions to Khambhat for the treatment. Medical history books, dated 1673 AD – 1726 AD have records that Hastiruci, medical scholar from Khambhat did significant work of Ayurvedic therapeutics. This is evidenced by the presence of practitioners and the influence of Ayurvedic texts, including Vaidya Vallabha. Khambhat also, has a history record of few medical colleges teaching Ayurvedia and Unani medicine.

Unani medicines, also known as Greco-Arabic medicine, has a history intertwined with Khambhat. The city had a significant Muslim population and Unani medicines was the cornerstone of Islamic medical tradition, imported into India via the port of Khambhat by Arab doctors in the medieval period. In the 7th century Ayurveda attracted the attention of Arab medical scholars from Baghdad to Khambhat medical institutions based in Khambhat for advanced medical studies. The introduction of modern medicine in Khambhat, as in other parts of India, was a gradual process influenced by British colonial rule. While the British initially tolerated and even utilized traditional Indian medicine systems like Ayurveda, they eventually promoted Western-style medicine, leading to its gradual dominance and the marginalization of indigenous practices.

Other historical records for Khambhat Khambhat had a dedicated veterinary clinic to treat birds as early as 1539. First of its kind in Western part of India. At a time when veterinary education was in the early development era around the world, Khambhat had a veterinary clinic to treat birds in the 16th century. It was one of the oldest known veterinary hospitals in the world. It not only served avian species but also drew admiration for its work. Italian traveler Pietro d' Valle who sailed from Venice to Khambhat in the 17th century described this clinic with all sorts of birds like cocks, hens, pigeons, peacocks, ducks. It was handed over by Nawab of Khambhat to state government, now upgraded by the central government. Upgradation in the field-level veterinary hospital is important not only from historical perspective but because Khambhat is also home of wetlands attracting migratory birds. The migratory birds that get injured and brought to hospital for treatment.

Dr.J. Nanavati brought homeopathy to Gujarat and set 2 dispensaries one in Ahmedabad and other in Khambhat in 1889. Dr R.K. Shah (Kanti kaka of Khambhat) become the first president of Council of Homoeopathic Society of India in the year 1957. Modern-day Khambhat has a network of healthcare professionals, including doctors specializing in various fields and high class hospitals providing medical services to the community. While it's difficult to pinpoint the exact number of medical professionals including doctors and medics who have settled around the world, the Dawoodi Bohra community, with its roots in Khambhat, has a significant global presence.


